5. <u>SECRETARY'S REPORT</u>

A. Technology and Research Park Update -

Mr. Baroody informed the EDA the Tech Park board made a formal request to the Board of Supervisors, and were granted, seed funding in the amount of \$500,000. The immediate goals are to hire an Executive Director and lease space.

B. Business Appreciation Week Update -

Mr. Baroody updated the EDA on the upcoming Business Appreciation event to be held at the Jeff Rouse Swim and Sports Center on May 19, 2016. This year's theme will be sports tourism and the keynote speaker will be Olympian Jon Lugbill of Sportsbackers.

7. <u>COMMITTEE REPORTS</u>

A. US Route1 Property Committee Report

Negotiations continue with Lamar regarding the Billboards' revenue and terms of the current leases.

No proposals were received for the grading RFP's.

Mr. Newlin motioned to list the US 1 Property with Thalmiher for \$1.1M. Mr. Rowley seconded.

The re-zoning on the US1 property is moving forward to the Planning Commission scheduled for their first meeting in June.

B. Chatham Square Update

Mr. Johnson reported that closing is scheduled for August.

C. Germanna Committee Report -

HH Hunt has not yet conveyed the 25 ac. to the County for a Germanna Campus.

D. Aquia Town Center Committee Report -

The Apartment project is scheduled to open phase 1 summer 2016. The Mosaic commercial portion of the project has an approved site plan and is still in negotiation with Rite Aid.
